2023 JACK FROST PARADE GUIDELINES

- 1. NO THROWING CANDY or other items from floats, moving vehicles, or individuals! <u>Candy or other items can only be HANDED OUT DIRECTLY to parade viewers.</u>
- 2. YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ENTRY IN TO THE CHAMBER BY MONDAY, 27 NOVEMBER.
- 3. YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ENTRY LIGHTED, whether it is a float, trailer, vehicle, or walking individual. After all, it is the Jack Frost Festival of Lights parade! Units will be judged (0-10 points) for their lighting display. [Exception: municipal vehicles]
- 4. When you receive your line-up position number, please post this on your unit where it will be visible to the Parade judges.
- 5. Keep up with the parade pace (1 1/2 car lengths between entries). Keep watch in front and behind your unit. If the parade stops for a performance, stop with the parade, don't keep moving forward. If the parade is moving steadily, keep up with the vehicle in front (1 ½ car length) so the parade is nicely grouped for viewing
- 6. Please PUT SIGNS somewhere on your unit so people can know who you are!
- 7. Parade participants are responsible for having their float in their designated parade section by 5:00 on parade night. If you have to leave your entry for any reason, you MUST NOTIFY your parade section leader.
- 8. NO SIRENS. Sirens scare animals and children.
- 9. NO fires of any kind (bonfires, torches, candles, etc.) on floats or in walking units.
- 10.NO stopping for performances unless with prior approval from the Parade Director.
- 11.NO person shall participate in the parade under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances.
- 12. Please follow the directions given you by your parade section director.
